
Welcome to the West Covina Hills SDA Church Family!

Health Nugget

Ask Marilyn

When one family member after another gets a cold or flu, and then the first one gets sick again, you often hear people say that the family keeps "passing it around." Does this really happen? Lori D., Lakeland, Fla.

No. A normal immune system can quickly whip up the appropriate antibodies to a virus it has defeated in the past, so reinfection with the same virus is extremely unlikely. And if you're wondering whether a virus can change enough from one family member to another that it could be caught a second time, that answer is no, too. Viruses (though they are wildly varied and defy much generalization) can and do evolve, which is why we need a flu vaccination every year. But they don't change that much, that fast, or our immune systems would be useless. Everybody would be sick all the time!
