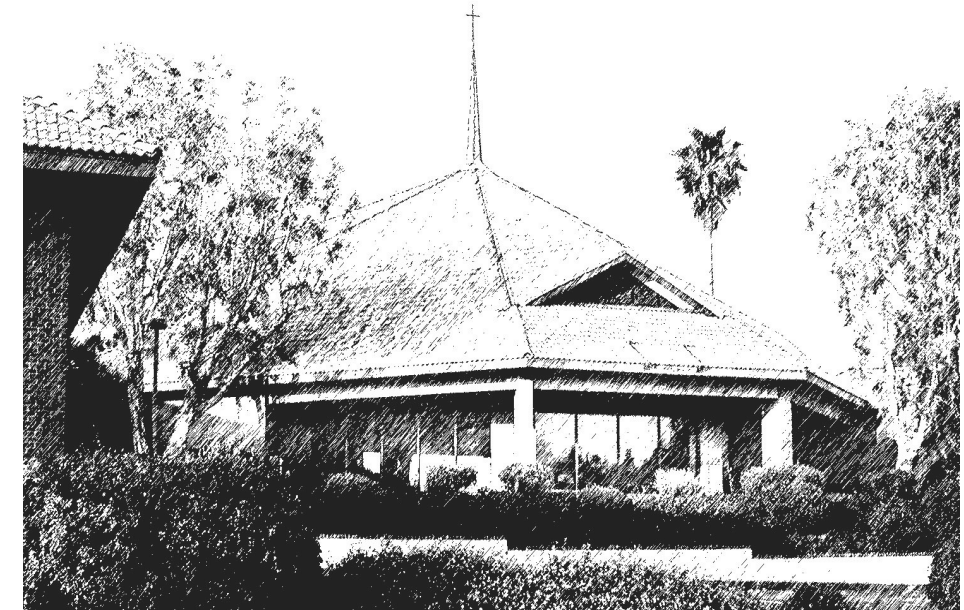

Welcome to The William Chunestudy Men's Chorus

William Chunestudy, director, received a Doctor of Musical Arts Degree in conducting from The Claremont Graduate University in Claremont, California in 1994. At Claremont he studied extensively with Roland Jackson in areas of historical performance practice and style analysis. His Master's Degree in choral conducting was earned at the University of Nebraska in Lincoln and his Bachelors Degree in Music Education was earned at Union College, also in Lincoln. Dr. Chunestudy has conducted workshops, clinics and festivals throughout the United States as well as in Mexico, the Caribbean, Europe and Asia. Dr. Chunestudy's career has included music teaching on the elementary, secondary and collegiate level. Dr. Chunestudy is the founder of the men's chorus and currently resides in Laurel, MD.

The William Chunestudy Men's Chorus (WCMC) exists for the purpose of praising God through music and furthering the work of proclaiming the Gospel of Jesus Christ to all nations. Established in fall of 2005 the men's chorus is made up of individuals from a wide variety of professions and 11 different cities throughout Southern California. Recently, the WCMC was the featured ensemble at the Oregon Men's Chorus Festival in Portland. In December of 2009 and 2010 the chorus was the featured ensemble in the Fallbrook Musical Arts Society Holiday Concert. In December, 2010 the men's chorus released their first album, *We Have This Hope*, an album of a cappella spirituals recorded as a tribute to the music of Wayne Hooper.
