

Football Teams Lose, Fans Pig Out on Fatty Foods

Here's an interesting way to illustrate how we deal with life's sadness and disappointment by turning somewhere else besides the Living God — in this case, to food. A recent study showed that when participants' favorite NFL team lost a game, saturated-fat consumption increased by as much as 28 percent following defeats and decreased by 16

A co-author of the study said, "When people feel their identity is threatened, they compensate by eating indulgent food. It's more difficult to resist temptation. No one ate broccoli after a defeat." Apparently football fans need to lighten up—and maybe put their trust in God rather than their favorite team's success.
