Health Nugget

The One-Rule Diet Wouldn't it be nice if there were one simple rule to help you shed weight? University of Massachusetts Medical School researchers think there is: Eat more fiber. In a yearlong study, published in the Annals of Internal Medicine, overweight adults who were told to eat more fiber lost nearly as much weight as those who were instructed to follow a more complex diet. The fiber group also did equally well at lowering their blood pressure and controlling their insulin levels, which is important for warding off diabetes. —Candy Sagon and Elizabeth Agnvall
