

If yours give you a blank stare when you ask about their day, mommy blogger Liz Evans has some tips you might want to try. Before Evans was a mom to three, she was a teacher and comes with an expert's eye on how to get kids to spill.

Her post 25 Ways to Ask Your Kids "How Was School Today?" WITHOUT asking them "How was School Today? Has had more than two million page views already, and she later added more questions for older kids. - #13. Who would you like to play with at recess that you've never played with before?
- #14. Tell me something good that happened today.
- #15. What word did your teacher say most today?
- #16. What do you think you should do/learn more of at school?
- #17. What do you think you should do/learn less of at school?
- #18. Who in your class do you think you could be nicer to?
- #19. Where do you play the most at recess?
- #20. Who is the funniest person in your class? Why is he/she so funny?
