Think Blue

Blueberries are packed with antioxidants and phytoflavonoids, and are high in potassium and vitamin C. Not only can they lower your risk of heart disease and cancer, they are also anti-inflammatory. Much of the power of blueberries lies in their deep-blue color. That hue, a by-product of natural compounds, can help protect the brain's memory-carrying cells (neurons) from the damaging effects of oxidation and inflammation.
