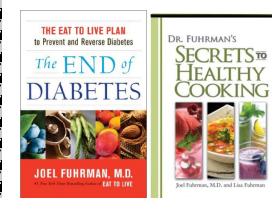
SUPER IMMUNITY G-BOMBS
