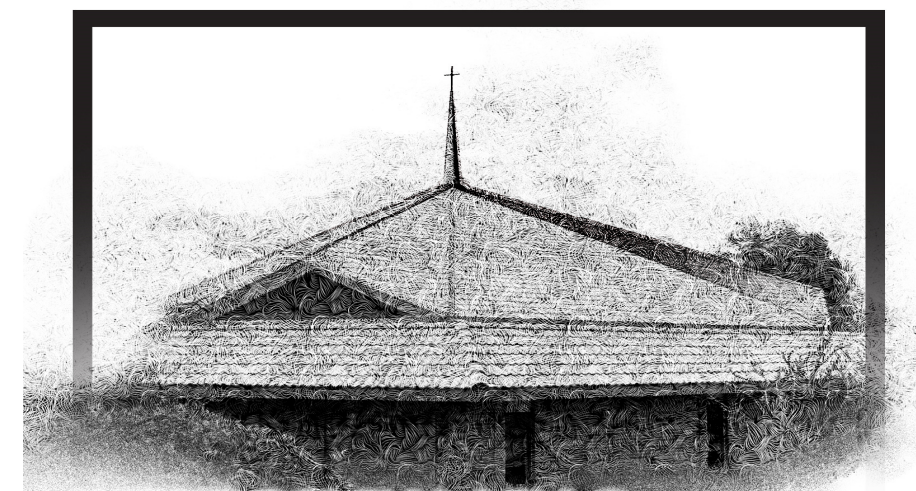

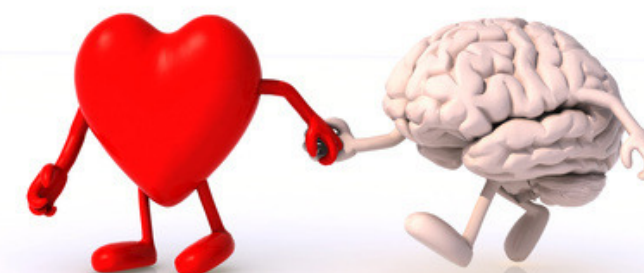

He has provided continuing medical education courses to physicians and health professionals around the world, and has been published numerous times in medical literature. He has also given numerous health education seminars to general public audiences worldwide. He is the founder and author of the highly successful Nedley Depression and Anxiety Recovery Program™. He developed the Depression and Anxiety Assessment Test™ (DAAT™) that is highly successful in identifying areas that an individual can do to improve depression, anxiety, and emotional intelligence. Health Nugget

Can Neuroscience Help Us Disciple Anyone?

Simply hearing that . . . sin is bad, or hearing correct theological information, does not rewire those pathways. What is required is a new set of habits, which will surely include confession and repentance and fellowship and accountability and the reading of Scripture, through which God can create new and deeper pathways that become the new "second nature," the "new creation."
