At Pathway to Health LA, 8,538 patients were seen and received 18,957 services, including 1,583 surgical procedures, 320 gynecologic surgeries, 25 major surgeries at White Memorial Medical Center, and 13 major surgeries at Glendale Adventist Medical Center. Thousands of patients received dental care, vision care, and a wide range of specialty care from cardiology to hydrotherapy. It was particularly exciting to witness the significant interest in our new legal and business counseling departments. The chaplaincy department was especially busy in Los Angeles, distributing more than 120,000 pieces of whole-person health literature. In the end, the total value of the free healthcare services was \$38,487,680, considerably exceeding our goal of \$20,000,000.

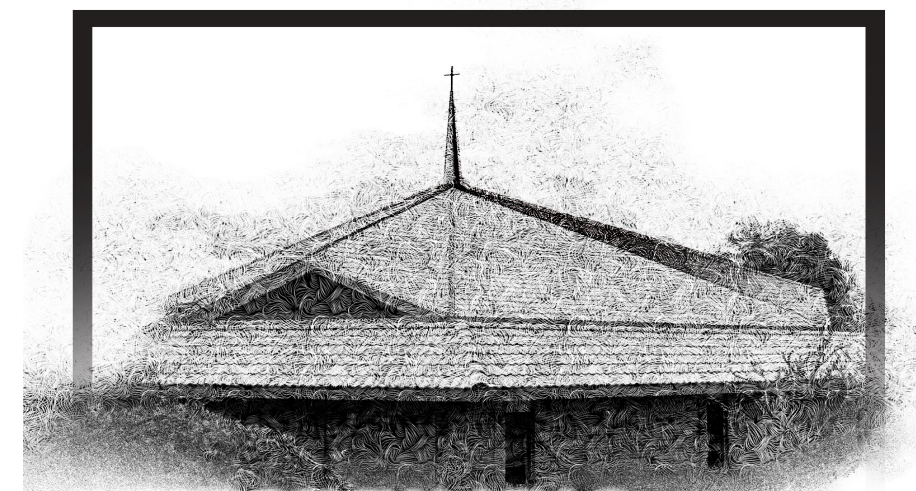

Can Neuroscience Help Us Disciple Anyone?

Simply hearing that . . . sin is bad, or hearing correct theological information, does not rewire those pathways. What is required is a new set of habits, which will surely include confession and repentance and fellowship and accountability and the reading of Scripture, through which God can create new and deeper pathways that become the new "second nature," the "new creation."
