

Theme of Worship

"Once to Every Man and Nation"

Over Christmas, I was reading a history of Nonviolence and realized that I had never read anything written by the late Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr. Of course, I had read "I Have a Dream" and "I Have Seen the Mountaintop," but these two famous speeches of his can hardly represent a man's entire life work.

Over MLK Weekend, I started reading more of his speeches in a collection called "All Labor Has Dignity." I was startled to find that King had a number of stock phrases that he used over and over again toward the end of his speeches. Some, you may recognize from "I Have a Dream," such as "We shall overcome," "Let justice roll," and "Let every mountain."

One of these stock phrases, though, came from the hymn we are singing today, which is based on a poem by the abolitionist James Russell Lowell. The part he quotes is from the fourth verse of the hymn: "Though truth's portion be the scaffold, and upon the throne be wrong; yet that scaffold sways the future." A scaffold is a place of suffering, and a throne a place of honor. To have compassion means, quite literally, "to suffer with" someone. When we have developed this ability to suffer with all of God's children, at last we will be able to call ourselves people of the truth.

15 Health Tips for the New Year

Tip # 3

Don't pop too many vitamins. Enthusiasm for vitamin pills is high, but evidence for their benefits is low. Try to get vitamins from foods and consider a multivitamin for insurance. Any woman thinking about getting pregnant should make sure to take a folic acid supplement. Women should get at least 1,000 mgs of calcium per day (1,200 mgs/day if you're past menopause) from food and/or supplements. Everyone should also get 800 international units of Vitamin D per day -- more than the federal "Recommended Daily Allowance."
