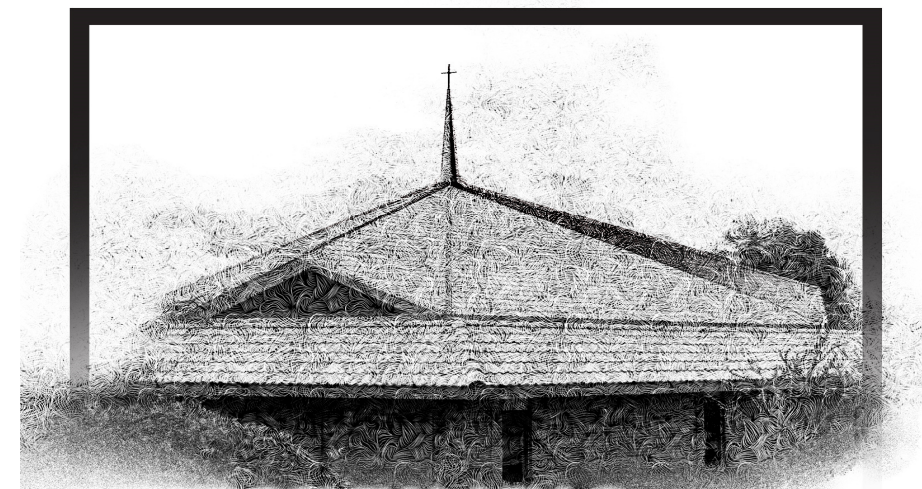

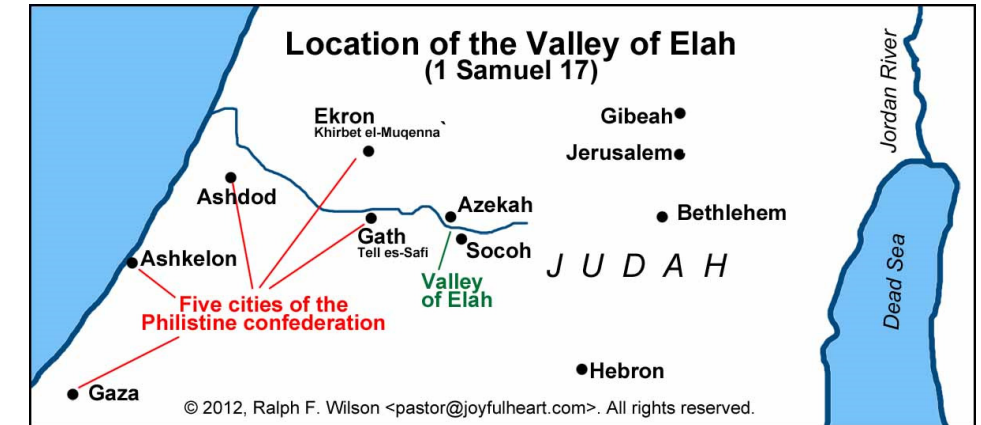

Theme of Worship

1 Samuel 17:1-3

Health Nugget

15 Health Tips for the New Year

Tip # 4

Eat at least two fish meals per week. The evidence is strong that the oils in darker types of fish, such as salmon, tuna, mackerel and herring, are beneficial for the heart and brain and may even lower risk of cancer. Safer fish alternatives include:
