

Jesus Gives Me What I Need to Serve Him

July 14, 2018

Matthew 10:8 (NKJV) "Heal the sick, cleanse the lepers, raise the dead, cast out demons. Freely you have received, freely give."

I Corinthians 12:7 (NIV) "Now to each one the manifestation of the Spirit is given for the common good."

1 Peter 4:10 (NKJV) "As each one has received a gift, minister it to one another, as good stewards of the manifold grace of God."

1 Corinthians 12:4-5 (NIV) "There are different kinds of gifts, but the same Spirit. There are different kinds of service, but the same Lord."

1 Corinthians 12:12-20 (NIV) "The body is a unit, though it is made up of many parts; and though all its parts are many, they form one body. So it is with Christ. For we were all baptized by one Spirit into one body—whether Jews or Greeks, slave or free—and we were all given the one Spirit to drink. Now the body is not made up of one part but of many. If the food should say, 'Because I am not a hand, I do not belong to the body,' it would not for that reason cease to be part of the body. And if the ear should say, 'Because I am not an eye, I do not belong to the body,' it would not for that reason cease to be part of the body. If the whole body were an eye, where would the sense of hearing be? If the whole body were an ear, where would the sense of smell be? But in fact God has arranged the parts in the body, every one of them, just as he wanted them to be. If they were all one part, where would the body be? As it is, there are many parts, but one body."

Ephesians 4:11-13 (NIV) "It was he who gave some to be apostles, some to be prophets, some to be evangelists, and some to be pastors and teachers, to prepare God's people for works of service, so that the body of Christ may be built up until we all reach unity in the faith and in the knowledge of the Son of God and become mature, attaining to the whole measure of the fullness of Christ."
