

As we gather to celebrate Christmas this year, we must be aware of this fact: Jesus was not born on December 25<sup>th</sup>. The events taking place at the time, like the traveling required to be part of the census, would indicate a time of the year more suitable for the trek, like spring or even summer. However, Christmas is a very important part of God's story. Therefore, we celebrate the event of Jesus' birth, not the date. So, because we don't have the exact date, we celebrate the birth of the Savior at this time.

So, this Christmas season, remember that Jesus came to people when you hear the words, "And there were shepherds living out in the fields nearby, keeping watch over their flocks at night. 9 An angel of the Lord appeared to them, and the glory of the Lord shone around them, and they were terrified. <sup>10</sup> But the angel said to them, 'Do not be afraid.
