



WORTHY: Sixth Seal

MESSAGE:
Revelation 6:12 (NIV) "I watched as he opened the sixth seal. There was a great earthquake. The sun turned black like sackcloth made of goat hair, the whole moon turned blood red,"
Revelation 6:13 "and the stars in the sky fell to earth , as figs drop from a fig tree when shaken by a strong wind."
Matthew 24:29 (NLT) "Immediately after the anguish of those days, the sun will be darkened, the moon will give no light, the stars will fall from the sky, and the powers in the heavens will be shaken."
Revelation 6:14 "The heavens receded like a scroll being rolled up, and every mountain and island was removed from its place."
