

April 20, 2019 The Rescue Mission

Hebrews 12:2 (CEV) "We must keep our eyes on Jesus, who leads us and makes our faith complete. He endured the shame of being nailed to a cross, because he knew that later on he would be glad he did."

Colossians 2:14 "God wiped out the charges and canceled the record of all the times we've disobeyed God's commandments. Jesus took our guilt on his own body and nailed it to the cross."

Ephesians 1:7 "In Christ we are set free by the blood of his death. And so we have forgiveness of sins because of God's rich grace."

Romans 4:25 "Jesus was handed over to die because of our sins, and he was raised from the dead to make us right with God."

1 Peter 2:24 "Jesus personally took our sins in his body on the cross so we could die to the grip of sin in our lives and be free to live in the right way. You are HEALED by his wounds!"

Isaiah 53:5 "But he (Jesus) was wounded and crushed for our sins. He was beaten that we might have peace; And He was whipped, so we could be healed!"

Matthew 9:35 (NIV) "Jesus went through all the towns and villages, teaching in the Jewish synagogues, preaching the Good News of the kingdom, and healing every disease and sickness."

Luke 5:17b (GNT) "The power of the Lord was present for Jesus to heal the sick."
