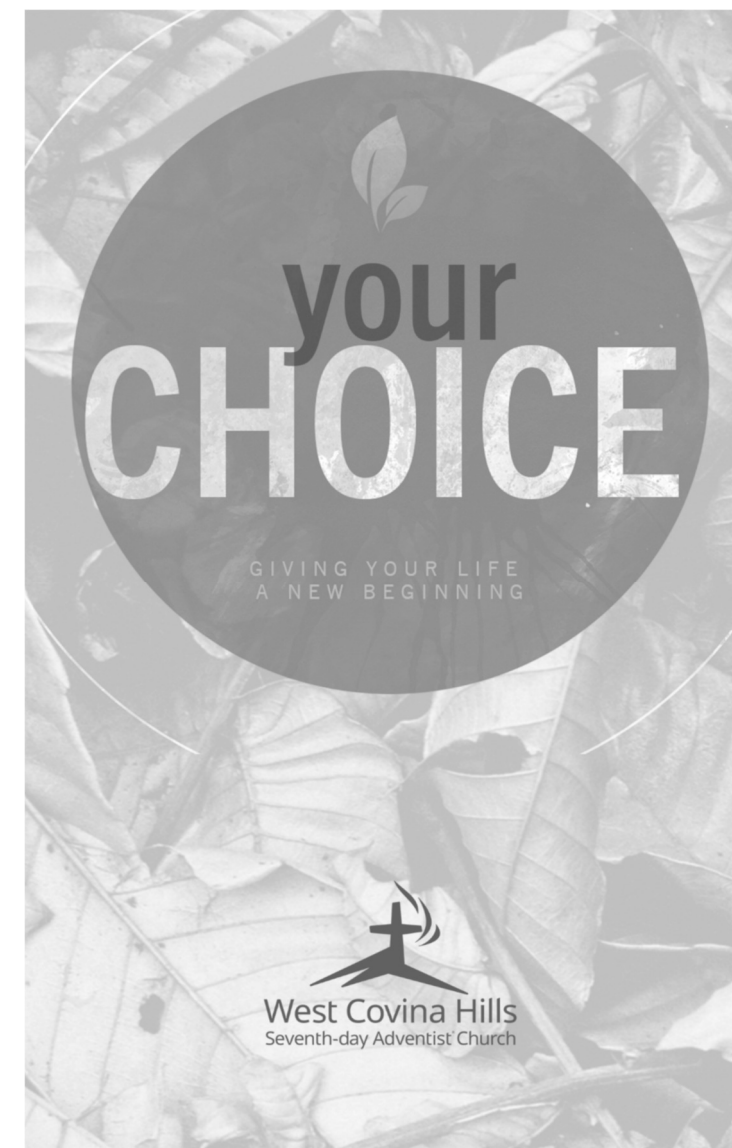

1. First test: _____. **David's response: A** _____

Psalm 51:1-3 “Have mercy on me, O God, according to your steadfast love; according to your abundant mercy blot out my transgressions. ²Wash me thoroughly from my iniquity, and cleanse me from my sin! ³For I know my transgressions, and my sin is ever before me.”

Psalm 51:17 “The sacrifices of God are a broken spirit; a broken and contrite heart, O God, you will not despise.”

2. Second test: _____. **David's response: A** _____

Psalm 118:5-6 “of my distress I called on the Lord; the Lord answered me and set me free.⁶The Lord is on my side; I will not fear. What can man do to me?”

Psalm 73:26 “My flesh and my heart may fail, but God is the strength of my heart and my portion forever.”

3. Third test: _____. **David's response: A** _____

Psalm 119:10 “With my whole heart I seek you; let me not wander from your commandments!”

2 Samuel 24:24 “But the king said to Araunah, ‘No, but I will buy it from you for a price. I will not offer burnt offerings to the Lord my God that cost me nothing.’ So David bought the threshing floor and the oxen for fifty shekels of silver.”

4. Fourth test: _____. **David's response: A** _____

1 Samuel 18:14 “And David had success in all his undertakings, for the Lord was with him.”

Psalm 115:1 “Not to us, O Lord, not to us, but to your name give glory, for the sake of your steadfast love and your faithfulness!”
